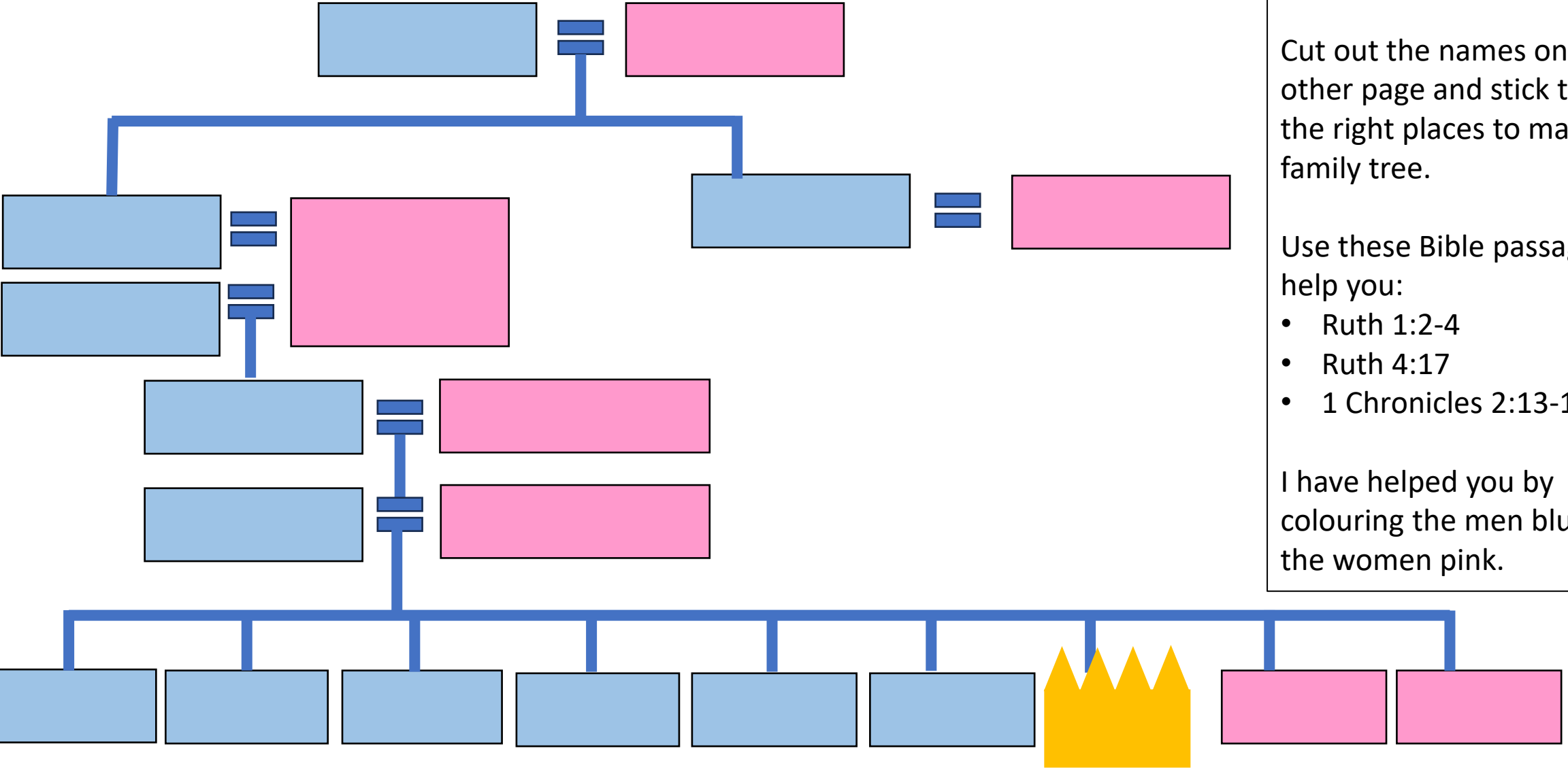


## 5<sup>th</sup> December – The only truly good person

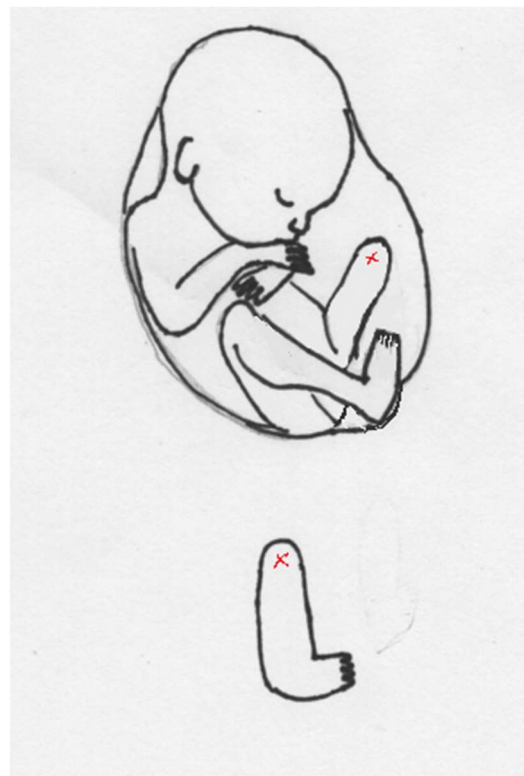

## December 15<sup>th</sup> – True Happiness

### Instructions

1. Colour in Elizabeth, the baby and the leg

Cut out this square →

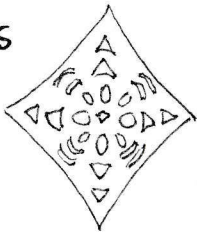
Fold it in half diagonally →
